### Main Street Reconstruction starts the week of April 2, 2018

The project is scheduled to be completed over a period of approximately 36 weeks and will include the installation of new storm sewer, sanitary sewer, watermain and traffic signalization upgrades. The existing road surface will also be upgraded to include streetscaping, pavement resurfacing, boulevard treatments and sidewalk replacement.

During this time the vehicular traffic travelling on the Main Street will be detoured around the work area in accordance with the approved traffic control plan.

### Clean Up will commence the week of April 9th, 2018.

During the Spring Clean Up, the Public Works staff will pick up winter sand and dead grass that has been raked to the roadside/curb only. We have a route we will be following starting with High Traffic Areas. This process can take up to six (6) weeks to complete every street in town.

This collection does not include branches/brush which can be disposed at the North Simcoe Transfer Station at 1700 Golfink Road. Fall Leaves will not be picked up throughout the spring clean-up/sweeping operations. The County of Simcoe will be providing Yard Waste Collection every other week starting April 23 until June 8. ## Municipal Election 2018

The 2018 Municipal Election will be held on Monday, October 22, 2018. Voters will elect Penetanguishene Council including the position of Mayor, Deputy Mayor, and seven Councillors (at large – no wards), as well as school board trustees. In the 2018 Municipal Election, Penetanguishene voters will be able to conveniently cast their ballot between October 9 – 22, 2018 using the Internet or Telephone. A Help Centre at Townhall will be available for those without access to a computer or who will require assistance in voting.
