Dear Mayor Leroux and Council:

The Federal Electoral Boundaries Commission has proposed significant changes to the electoral map across Canada, including Ontario.

There are two significant changes proposed for the riding of Simcoe North:

1. **Boundary changes:** Moving all parts of Oro-Medonte currently in Simcoe North to Barrie Springwater Oro-Medonte (the area commonly known as northeast of Line 9) – for example areas affected include: Hawkestone, Warminster and Bass Lake and others
2. **Name change proposal:** to rename Simcoe North to Penetanguishene – Couchiching

Interested parties (Town/City councils, First Nations and Indigenous communities, Chambers of Commerce, communities affected, including residents) are able to comment in person or by letter/email on the proposed changes for Simcoe North.
