Council

- Council viewed the <u>Employee Recognition for Years of Service video</u>, recognizing staff for their years of service in 2021.
- Council received a presentation from Principles Integrity regarding the Integrity Commissioner's 2021 Annual Report.

 - 2022-12 Being a By-law to establish a Pre-Servicing Agreement with Bay Moorings Marina Holdings GP Inc and Bay Mooring Marina Holdings Limited Partnership. (175 and 200 Fox Streets)
 - <u>2022-13</u> Being a By-law to Authorize the Entering into of an Agreement with Eramosa Engineering Inc. for the provision of SCADA Maintenance Services for the Water and Wastewater Divisions for a three (3) year term
